Listing Order Form

To ensure your proper placement alphabetically, be sure to distinguish between a division or subsidiary and the parent company. If the product is best identified with the division/subsidiary, give that name first; if the product is well known by the parent company's name, give that name first.

Examples:

CopCaps Div/Uniform Conglom
(This would be listed once, under "C")

Uniform Conglom/CopCaps Div
(This would be listed once, under "U")

Category Listings

Please take the time today to read through the product listings on pages 4-6 and select those that most closely describe the products/services offered by your company. Remember that **five free listings** are available even to nonadvertisers, and **additional listings** are available according to the size of the advertisement you place in the April Buyers' Guide issue (to determine how many listings you are entitled to, please see page 3).

1. Match the end use of your product to one or more of the fourteen sections (Administration, Communications, and so on) and check the boxes next to the applicable categories. Please do not select more listings than your advertisement size entitles you to. We welcome your suggestions for additional or revised categories in next year's buyers' guide.
2. Return to the Listing Order Form on page 3 and enter the five most important categories in priority order.
