



Police Chief Magazine Photo Contest Guidelines

- All photos must be submitted via the online submission form and must be accompanied by a signed consent form.
- There is no limit to the number of entries an individual or agency may submit; however, each photograph should be submitted separately.
- Photographs submitted after 11:59 pm ET on May 1, 2024 will not be considered eligible.

Content

- To qualify, photos must be relevant to policing.
- Each image should have a caption or description (enter on form).
- Photographs must have been taken on or after May 1, 2023.
- Photographs may not include obscene, offensive, or violent content. Inappropriate images, as determined by IACP staff, will be disqualified.

Technical Specifications

- To be considered, photos must be 300 dpi or higher at 5" x 7" (1500 pixels x 2100 pixels). Larger images are acceptable. (Both landscape and portrait orientation photos will be accepted.)
Please note that while many smartphones now take high-resolution photos, this is not true of all models/phones. We recommend checking the resolution prior to submittal.
- All photos must be taken by amateur photographers (no professional photographs permitted).
- Special filters should not be used.
- Preferred file formats are jpeg (.jpg), TIFF (.tif), or PDF. Do not embed the image in a Word or PowerPoint document for submission.
